1. OUT OF BOUNDS

- a) The boundary is beyond any of the fences forming the course boundaries.
- b) The boundary is beyond the line of white posts to the right of holes Rocket, Long Trail, Bill Hector.
- c) The car park, practice putting green and path leading to the 1st tee as defined by the white line.

2. ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS & INTEGRAL OBJECTS (Rule 16)

- a) The steps in bunkers.
- b) All roads and green astroturf paths.
- c) The red stakes to the right of the Lagoon hole.
- d) The concrete blocks on the Gare and Chapel Open.
- e) The bell on the Chapel Open.

Immovable Obstructions close to Putting Green (sprinkler heads).

In addition to the types of interference described in Rule 16.1a. when a ball lies in the general area, interference also exists if an immovable obstruction is: on the player's line of play, is within two club-lengths of the putting green, and is within two club-lengths of the ball. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b. (Exception – There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable).

Integral Parts of the Course

- a) Artificial bunker faces

Ground Under Repair

- a) All areas defined by blue stakes or lines are GUR from which play is prohibited.
- b) Ruts caused by course machinery is GUR on closely mown area.

3. PENALTY AREAS (Rule 17)

- a) Yellow Penalty Areas are indicated by Yellow stakes and defined by Yellow Lines.
- b) Red Penalty Areas are indicated by Red stakes and defined by Red lines

4. WRONG PUTTING GREEN

- a) The Practice Putting Green
